Women's Studies Certificate (Worksheet)

The Women's Studies Certificate will give students a focus on issues concerning women and gender within a variety of academic disciplines. It can give cohesion to a student's electives within the AAS degree, lead students to a specialization in the area of women's studies for some employment purposes, or prepare them for a major or a minor in Women's Studies at other institutions.

The Women's Studies Certificate requires a minimum of 15 credits earned with a grade of C or better. Up to 3 credits can be transferred from institutions outside the UW-Colleges. Credits for the Certificate must include the following:
