Are you receiving financial aid? READ THIS!

Financial aid funds will be based on the credits you are enrolled in on Wednesday 9/16/09 at midnight. Your aid may be reduced if you are enrolled for less than 12 credits.

Return your financial aid award letter to accept any loan funds you wish to receive. Be sure to complete **Loan Entrance Counseling** and your **Master Promissory Note** at <http://www.uwc.edu/financial-aid>. Financial aid funds will be credited to your account on Friday, 9/18/09 as will checks for any remaining funds.

If you do not have sufficient financial aid to pay all of your tuition and fees by the payment deadline, contact the Business Office to make payment arrangements before the payment deadline. If you have accepted financial aid it will be deducted from the amount owed as a pending financial aid waiver. If you have sufficient financial aid to pay your entire balance due, the waiver will prevent any late fee from being applied to your account. Waivers are removed from all accounts after 9/18/09.
