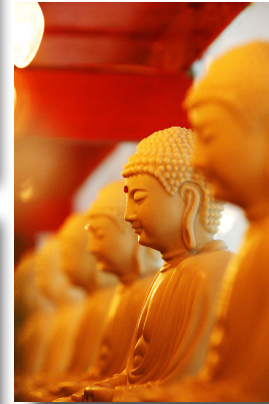

## About Michael Mullooly

Michael Mullooly, Buddhist Studies instructor for UWM at Waukesha Continuing Education and founder of the program, stated that, "The Buddhist Studies certificate program is an exciting opportunity to expand one's own horizons. From its roots in Asia twenty-five centuries ago, Buddhism now stands alongside the great spiritual traditions of humanity".

Mullooly was part of a Buddhist Studies Ph.D. program at UW-Madison. When the program closed in 2003, he graduated with a masters degree in the Languages and Cultures of Asia. After that, he traveled to Asia, living in Japan for three months, China for two months, and Thailand, Cambodia, Vietnam and Burma for six months.

In 2006, he began teaching courses with UWM at Waukesha Continuing Education, "My aim," he said, "is to share the compelling insights of this quiet religion with a Western audience".
